Weekday mornings in Rouen are with French language lessons

- 2-Sat 9 Jul Arrive Paris. Transfer to Paris Residence. Head to the Eiffel Tower for a cruise on the Seine River! Dinner at residence and early night.
- 3-Su 10 Jul Mass at Notre Dame Cathedral & enjoy a walk on the Seine River bank to the Quartier Latin. Late afternoon train transfer to Rouen. Settle in host families
- 4-Mo 11 Jul Rouen Orientation: take a walk in the beautiful city centre
- 5-Tu 12 Jul Cooking Class – make & taste local "Specialités Normandes"
- 6-Wed 13 Jul Board game or film afternoon at the school
- 7-Thu 14 Jul Visit to the Musée Jean d'Arc
- 8-Fri 15 Jul Free afternoon for shopping or revising your French verbs
- 9-Sat 16 Jul Day trip: Visit Bayeux's Tapestry Museum and the WW2 landing beach or WW2 Day: Omaha Beach/Visitor Centre and Caen War Memorial
- 10-Sun 17 Jul Day in the host family
- 11-Mo 18 Jul Thematic visit: Rouen's street names
- 12-Tu 19 Jul Visit Camembert and discover how the famous cheese is made!
- 13-Wed 20 Jul Free afternoon for shopping or revising your French verbs
- 14-Thu 21 Jul Painting Lesson "Paint like Monet"
- 15-Fri 22 Jul Goodbye tea & certificates – evening train to Paris & settle down at Paris Residence
- 16-Sat 23 Jul Top sights of Paris: Champs Elysées, Arc de Triomphe & Eiffel Tower.
- 17-Sun 24 Jul Transfer to airport for departure
- 19-Mon 25 Jul Arrive Sydney
